TITLE: A TRIP TO ITALY - from Italian Movies to India

REGULATIONS

IED - Istituto Europeo di Design in cooperation with Istituto Italiano di Cultura in Mumbai, will award nr. 1 special merit-based scholarship to attend the summer course Design – Made in Italy, held in IED Firenze campus in July 2025.

The candidates (over 18 years old) can show their creativity through the production of a short video based on the brief indicated in these regulations.

CONTEST AND CREATIVE WORKS ("CONCEPT") OF THE CANDIDATE

<u>Brief</u>: "Over the years, Italian cinema has thrilled millions of viewers by portraying emotions and landscapes recognized worldwide. A cultural movement like Neorealism, for example, was a collection of voices and faces that allowed many to discover post-war Italy, full of contradictions and a desire for redemption. Today, we ask you to talk about an Italian film that, for various reasons, represented an important moment in your creative journey. Feel free to choose from the recent past or the long history of cinema, but it's important to convey the emotions, reflections, or moods that emerged after watching it".

Technical Requirements for Contest Submission

General Guidelines:

- 1. **Objective:** Participants are required to create a video, no longer than 2 minutes, that conveys the impact of an Italian film on their creative journey. The video should focus on:
 - a. Emotions
 - b. Reflections
 - c. Moods Evoked by the film, which can be chosen from any period of Italian cinema with no limitations, including even the most recent works.

2. Video Specifications:

- a. Duration: Maximum 2 minutes (120 seconds).
- b. Resolution: Minimum of 1080p (1920x1080).
- c. Format: Accepted file formats include MP4, MOV, AVI.
- d. **Aspect Ratio:** 16:9 (widescreen) or 9:16 (vertical). Other aspect ratios will not be accepted unless pre-approved for artistic reasons.
- e. File Size: Maximum file size is 500MB.

3. Audio Requirements:

- a. **Soundtrack/Music:** Original compositions or royalty-free music only. No copyrighted material allowed unless properly licensed and documented.
- b. **Dialogue:** If applicable, must be in **Italian** or **English** with English subtitles if the dialogue is in another language.
- c. **Audio Quality:** Clear and free of distortion, recommended to use a minimum **44.1 kHz** sample rate and **16-bit audio**.

4. Submission Format:

- a. The video must be uploaded via the provided email address (details will be given upon registration).
- b. A submission text including details about the participant, chosen film, and a brief explanation (150-200 words) of the creative journey must accompany the video.
- c. **Deadline:** All submissions must be received by November 30th at 11:59 PM, UTC +5:30.

5. Video Content:

- a. **Film Focus:** The chosen Italian film must be explicitly mentioned either verbally or through on-screen text.
- b. **Visual Style:** Participants are encouraged to use a creative approach (animation, live-action, mixed media, etc.) but must maintain a respectful and appropriate tone.
- c. **Copyright Considerations:** Clips or images from the selected film are only allowed if they adhere to **fair use guidelines** or are properly licensed. Original or royalty-free visuals are preferred.

6. Participant Eligibility:

- a. Open to individuals or groups of up to 3 people.
- b. Participants must be 18 years or older and residing in India
- c. All nationalities and backgrounds are welcome.

7. **Evaluation Criteria:** Submissions will be judged based on the following:

- a. **Relevance to the Brief:** How well the video conveys the creative impact of the chosen Italian film.
- b. **Originality & Creativity:** The uniqueness of the storytelling and presentation.
- c. **Technical Quality:** Visual and audio clarity, adherence to video specifications.
- d. **Emotional Impact:** The strength of the conveyed emotions and reflections.

Evaluation will occur exclusively according to the unquestionable judgement of the panel of representatives from IED - Istituto Europeo di Design and IIC Mumbai.

8. Rights & Permissions:

- a. The intellectual property rights of the Concepts always pertain to the author. The Candidate, with his/her participation to the Contest, giving up any indemnity and/or refund and independently from the awarding of a prize, grants for free and permanently to IED the right to use submitted Concepts to promote and divulge the Website and IED activities, with mention of the Concept's author.
- b. Participants must own all rights to the materials used in their submission or provide documentation of licensing for any third-party content.

Submission Confirmation:

- c. Upon successful submission, participants will receive a confirmation email.
- d. Multiple entries are not allowed.

9. Support & Inquiries:

a. For technical support or inquiries, participants can reach out to the contest team via india@ied.it or contact form on the submission platform.

PRIZES:

The Competition will award one 100% Scholarship for the Summer course in Design – Made in Italy held in IED Firenze. The course will be dispensed during the month of July

2025 with no possibility of fruition in another academic year. Winners will have to go through the application process of the course (which can be checked at the following link: www.ied.edu). Travel fees, housing and all other costs shall be covered by the winner.
